## RULES ON ENROLLING IN COURSES OUTSIDE THE CURRICULUM

## For Enrichment Purposes

Enrollment in courses outside the curriculum for enrichment purposes may be allowed under the following conditions:

1. the student must be in good academic standing and up-to-date with the requirements of their curriculum;
2. the student may enroll in one (1) or two (2) courses per semester as long as the total load does not exceed 21 units per semester;
3. enrollment shall be endorsed by the Program Adviser and approved by the Department Chair/Institute Director; and
4. the student must be informed by the Registration/Program Adviser of the consequences of enrolling in courses outside the curriculum, such as added burden on academic load and possible delay in graduation.

## For Shifting Purposes

Enrollment in courses outside the curriculum in preparation for shifting may be allowed under the following conditions:

1. the student must indicate intention to shift by writing the Department Chair/Institute Director of the home unit;
2. the student must shift within one (1) year, subject to compliance with the admission requirements of the admitting unit;
3. if the student cannot shift within one (1) year for whatever reason, the student shall follow the curriculum of the original degree program; and
4. the student must be informed by the Registration/Program Adviser of the consequences of enrolling in courses outside the curriculum, such as added burden on academic load and possible delay in graduation.
